**HIMAN BERNADT COLLECTION
(NMAP2009/13)**

This collection is made up of some of the legal matters of Mr Nelson Mandela attended to by Frank, Bernadt & Joffe between 1966 and 1990. These were the files of the legal firm Frank, Bernadt & Joffe concerning certain legal matters on behalf of the client, Mr Nelson Mandela. The files were donated to Nelson Mandela after his release from prison. The papers detail examples of his endeavors to secure rights for prisoners through challenging the legality of acts carried out by prison officers.

History

Nelson Mandela files from the legal firm Frank, Bernadt & Joffe concerning certain legal matters from 1966 -1990.

This collection was donated to Mr Nelson Mandela by the law firm that handled his legal affairs when he was in Prison. The collection compiles some of the legal matters of Mr. Nelson Mandela attended to by Frank, Bernadt & Joffe between 1966 and 1990. These files, referred to as 'the collection', were in the possession of attorney Himan Bernadt, at that time senior partner of the firm. During the above period owing to the emigration and death of certain partners the name of the firm was changed from Frank, Bernadt and Joffe to Bernadt, Vukic, Potash and Getz and the reference in the collection to Frank, Bernadt and Joffe includes the new name Bernadt, Vukic, Potash and Getz. These documents offer insight into Mr. Mandela's dealings with the prison services, as well as information about a number of legal cases he engaged in while a prisoner.

The first part of the collection deals with certain events at Robben Island Prison during the 1960s. The harsh treatment of prisoners has been well documented, as has Mr. Mandela's attempts to get the prison services to behave more humanely. These papers detail examples of his endeavors to secure rights for prisoners through challenging the legality of acts carried out by prison officers. In August 1966 Mr. Mandela was charged with having illegal possession of the newspaper 'Die Landstem'. During proceedings Mr. Mandela asked for the case to be dropped because he did not feel he would receive a 'fair and proper trial' due to the racist composition of the prison court. In November the same year he was again charged, this time with contravening Prison regulation 99 (1) (b) by disobeying a lawful order. He once more chose to appeal the charge and evidence from himself and other witnesses are included within the papers.

In 1966 Mrs. Winnie Mandela approached Frank, Bernadt & Joffe to investigate reports that Mr. Mandela was being mistreated by prison warders and was soon to lose his privileges. Correspondence relating to this and Helen Suzman's subsequent visit to the Island are included.

At the end of 1966 the Transvaal Law Society, at the instigation of the Minister of Justice, took measures to strike Mandela off the roll of practicing attorneys because of his conviction. Mandela contested the action and demanded the right to defend himself, to go to Pretoria and to obtain access to law books. Several months later, Mandela received notification that the case was no longer being pursued.

Mandela continued to be faced with challenges from the government and in 1967 the Department of Justice included him in a list of members and active supporters of the Communist Party. This section details the appeals by Mr. Mandela and a fellow prisoner Wilton Mkwayi to their listing. Mandela denied membership of the Communist Party and asked for the Department of Justice to provide evidence that he was a member. After four months he was informed that his name was not going to be included on the list.

In May 1969 Mrs. Winnie Mandela was arrested, detained and later charged under the Suppression of Communism Act. The collection details correspondence over Mr. Mandela's attempts to find information about his wife and make arrangements regarding his family in 1969 and 1970. This section further deals with an unsuccessful attempt by Mr. Mandela to claim a refund of his contributions to the law society.

The main part of the collection details a legal challenge to the prison services by Mr. Mandela over a prisoner's right to confidentiality with his/her attorney. Sparked by an incident with the Officer Commanding Robben Island, Mr. Mandela faced another charge in 1977, this time for allegedly being 'insolent or disrespectful'. Mr. Mandela chose to appeal, and the case was subsequently dropped, but he then became involved in a further legal wrangling over the privacy of 'privileged' documents passed between a prisoner and attorney. The case was lost in the Supreme Court and went to appeal. The collection contains all the legal documents regarding the case and appeal, as well as correspondence in connection with the case.

A further section of the collection includes general correspondence regarding certain personal and family matters of Mr. Mandela. In particular it deals with literature that Mr. Mandela requested for his studies, an award received on behalf of Mr. Mandela by his grandson Mandla Mandela and attempts to provide educational assistance for family members. Details of the visits of Lord Bethell and Professor Dash to Mr. Mandela in 1985 are also included.

The final sections of the catalogue incorporate the legal literature used within the cases detailed above and copies of those sent to Mr. Mandela for his consideration. A large file of notes made by the various solicitors serves as an appendix; these notes are often replicated in the documents but may be of interest to those concerned with charting the entire legal process.

The files in the main have been re-organised chronologically although emphasis has been placed on ensuring that each case is stored as true to the original form as possible.

Scope and Content Note
